IMMUNIZATIONS:

ATTENTION PARENTS OF PRESCHOOL, Jr. K, KINDERGARTEN, 1ST and 7TH GRADE STUDENTS

Preschool, Jr. K, & Kindergarten: Current Immunization records and copies of birth certificates must be on file with the School Office by August 1st.

First Grade: School physicals must be on file with the School Office prior to August 1st.

TUITION PAYMENTS (*Elementary and Secondary Only*)

If you have registered for the 2010-2011 school year, then you have also signed your financial contract and set up your payment plan.

Tuition payments will be handled by the CMCS Accounting Department. We are offering several payment plans. One is through an ACH banking system processed through the CMCS Accounting Department. We will continue to accept cash, checks, money orders, cashier's checks and credit cards. There is a processing fee for each transaction: For ACH, the fee is \$10.00 each transaction, and for cash, check, money order, cashier's check or credit card, the fee is \$15.00. Credit cards also have a CV fee. You will need to bring in a voided check to set up your account for the ACH process.

Payments: Please be reminded that tuition payments are due on the 5th or 20th of each month, beginning June 20th or July 5th. Tuition payments are based on a 12-month payment plan (June 20-May 20) or (July 5-June 5).

If you are planning to pay in full, the full payment is due on or before July 1.

Late Charges: All payments are considered late on the 5th day after your scheduled due date that you have chosen. On the 10th or the 25th day of the month a \$25 late fee will be applied to your account.

NSF Fees: Please note that if your ACH, check, or credit card payment goes NSF (non-sufficient funds), you will be charged a \$25 NSF fee after bank notification to CMCS (within 2 days). This charge also pertains to any closed accounts or authorization revoked notices, and is neither reversible nor negotiable. We will then re-draw your ACH or credit card tuition payment plus the \$25 NSF fee and a \$25 late fee on CMCS' next scheduled draw day (the 5th or 20th). If paying by check, your late payment plus a \$25 NSF fee and a \$25 late fee will be due on or before the next CMCS billing due date (5th or 20th).

Please contact the school accounting department if you have any questions or need more information regarding this service.

PRESCHOOL:

If you have enrolled your preschooler for the fall, you can expect to receive a phone call from the Director during the month of June or July to schedule an appointment to complete the required forms for enrollment and to sign your tuition contract. At that time, the material fee and emergency kit fee are due, if you have not already paid them.

If you haven't enrolled yet, there is still space available. You may pick up the enrollment forms from the elementary school office over the summer, Tuesday through Thursday between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., or download them from our website. (Click on the preschool-elementary campus link to get to the preschool information.)

Kindergarten - 8:15 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. (For your convenience, parents of Kindergartners may drop their Kindergarten child off as early as 7:45 a.m. for supervised free play time in their classroom without a daycare charge. Kindergarten students who are not picked up by 3:00 p.m. will be placed in after school care. Daycare billing for Kindergarten students does not begin until 3:15 p.m.)

PRESCHOOL & ELEMENTARY HOT LUNCH PROGRAM and KITCHEN INFORMATION

Students may bring a lunch from home or buy lunch from the CMCS Kitchen. The elementary hot lunch is \$4.00 and consists of the menu entrée, fruit and/or vegetable, and a drink. (Prices subject to change).

You may purchase a lunch card for \$40.00, which covers ten lunches. This card may be used as either a “family” card, for 3 or more siblings at the elementary campus, or an “individual” card. All students are encouraged to have a lunch card on file in the Kitchen. If students do not have a lunch card, they may bring in cash or a check made payable to “Enlightened Foods” in the amount of the lunch purchased..

Lunch cards (Preschool-6th grade), snack cards (1st-6th grade), and milk cards (Preschool, Jr. K and Kindergarten students only) are available at the elementary campus only and can be purchased at “Meet Your Teacher Day” or in the office.

JR. & SR. HIGH CAMPS: Both Jr. and Sr. High are going up to Green Valley Camp again this year for a time of fellowship and fun on Tuesday, August 31st and returning the afternoon of Thursday, September 2nd. The fee for camp this year is \$175.

Permission slips, registration forms, a list of items to bring, and directions **will be posted** in the summer section of the school website as soon as they are available to us. **It is very important that you 1) print out each of these documents, 2) complete the required forms and bring them with you 3) along with the camp fee of \$175, to “Get Your Act Together Day” on Wednesday, August 4th.**

Please continue to check the school website for up-to-the-minute camp information as it becomes available. Exact amount of camp fee to bring to “Get Your Act Together Day” will also be posted.

JR./SR. HIGH PICTURES: There’s an added bonus to “Get Your Act Together Day” (Wednesday, August 4th) – it’s “Picture Day” too! So come ready to have your photo snapped! The photographers will be set up in the gym and they’ll be expecting you to stop by. **A pricing flyer will be posted on the school website in the summer section.** Please notice that money is **not due** on the day your photo is taken. Instead, you will receive proofs to choose from and ordering information will be included at that time.

MANDATORY SENIOR PARENT MEETING: All parents of seniors need to plan on attending this meeting, on Tuesday, September 14th at 6:30 p.m. in the sanctuary. You will receive important information regarding your student’s senior year.

EAST COAST HISTORIC STUDY TOUR: For those interested in traveling with us on this fabulous trip, information will be given to parents at “Back to School Night” in students’ History classes.

SCIENCE DISCOVERY TRIP TO HAWAII: Come join us for an amazing look at God’s science in action! The price (which includes airfare, hotel, excursions, and meals) is roughly \$1,500 per person. A fundraising committee will be established so that students can earn their own money to finance their trip. Sign-ups and a \$50 non-refundable deposit will be accepted at “Get Your Act Together Day” on Wednesday, August 4th.

PARKING PASSES: We will be issuing parking permits (\$25.00) on “Get Your Act Together Day”. If you will be driving to school and parking in the school parking lot, you’ll need to purchase your pass on one of these days. A copy of your driver’s license and proof of insurance is required. If you were issued a pass last year, please stop by the **parking pass table** and we will renew your permit.

Important Policy Regarding Ipods, Gameboys, and Cell Phones

IPODS ~ will **no longer** be allowed **on campus** (including the parking lot) at **any** time. This includes backpacks, lockers, etc., whether it’s before, during, OR after school hours.

GAMEBOYS and any other type of electronic devices ~ the policy will continue to be enforced. They are also **not allowed** at any time on campus whether before, during, or after school hours.

If any of the above devices are seen with a student or on campus at any time (whether the students are using them or not), they will be taken away and the parent will be contacted to come and pick them up, which only they can do. Appropriate disciplinary measures may be applied when necessary.

CELL PHONES ~ will continue to be allowed on campus, **but** they must be kept **TURNED OFF** completely and **must be KEPT PUT AWAY** either in a **purse, backpack, or locker** during regular school hours (see school hours section). This is for ANY type of usage (i.e. camera, calculator, etc.). They can be used before or after school hours, if being used appropriately.

If a cell phone is seen out by a staff member (whether it is being used or not), it will be taken away and sent to the office. The parent will be contacted and only they can come to pick it up. Appropriate disciplinary measures may be applied when necessary.

Important Policy Regarding Skateboarding

SKATEBOARDING is not allowed anywhere on school grounds before, during, or after school. This includes both elementary and secondary campuses and both parking lots. "After school" means through the remainder of the evening. If students are riding their skateboard to and from school, they must pick it up and carry it as soon as they enter either parking lot, and place it securely in their locker. Any time they have the skateboard on campus, they must be holding on to it....not standing, sitting, riding, or playing with it in any other manner.

The only exception would be on Wednesday evenings after 5:00pm...until church is dismissed for the evening.

ATTENTION: No sports fee will be waived or returned once a student is a member of the team.

Definition of “member of the team”: If try-outs are made for selection on an athletic team: A student is considered a member of the team once try-outs are completed and the student has accepted being a member of the sports team.

If there are no try-outs for the athletic team: A student is considered a member of the athletic team once they have participated in the first practice, seven days before the first game.

ALL JR. HIGH / HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS:

Mandatory Fall Sports Night is Tuesday, July 14th. (Jr. High: 6:00 p.m./Sr. High: 7:00 p.m.) **At least one parent of the family must attend** for initial sign-ups and information. All winter and spring sports will have a mandatory sports night on Thursday, August 5, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. in the gymnasium. Information regarding off season training, official sign-ups and spirit pack ordering will take place that night.

Students who have not purchased a Warrior Card will need to pay to enter all home high school athletic games, regardless of their event responsibilities.

- o The Warrior Card may be purchased for \$25, and will be available beginning on “Get Your Act Together Day” (August 5th). Sales will continue throughout the school year.
